ALCOHOL/SMOKE/SUBSTANCE FREE LIVING ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Substance-Free Purpose

Naismith Hall is a substance-free residence hall in order to provide the option of a residential lifestyle free from the possession of alcohol, non-prescription or other illicit drugs, or tobacco products. Members of the community are expected to respect and adhere to the substance-free values in order to uphold the well-being and honor of their peers.

Substance-Free Guidelines

The possession or use of alcohol, controlled substances, and tobacco products (including “vaping”) by residents or their guests is prohibited in student rooms and public spaces at Naismith Hall. If residents or their guests choose to use such substances outside of Naismith Hall, the results of that choice must not have a negative impact upon residents or property upon return to Naismith Hall. Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests.

Consequences of Violating Guidelines

Non-compliance with the Substance-Free Policy at any time during the academic year may result in the termination of your housing contract or contract sanctions.
